STREETLIGHTS IN WOODCREEK

Most of the streetlights in Woodcreek are part of the municipal services provided to our community by the City of Conway. These services are paid for by our city tax payments and additional city fees.



If you notice that a nearby streetlight is out or needs maintenance, please report it to the Board at: wcboard2@woodcreekatconway.com.

We will notify Horry Electric for repairs. Please provide a pole number if you are able to, or an accurate location.

For your personal, electrical service outages: dial 843-369-2212. You will be linked to Horry Electric's outage reporting system.

When seconds count, help your emergency provider find you by displaying your house number in a conspicuous location on your home and in a manner to be legible from the street. House numbers on mail boxes may need to be replaced periodically in order to remain legible.

TREE MAINTENANCE ON YOUR PROPERTY

The City of Conway has very specific requirements for **pruning or trimming trees**. For example, you will need a permit if: the tree is a Live Oak or greater than 30” in diameter, measured at 4 ft. 6 in. from ground level.
